

## Clubhouse Dress Code

Jefferson Country Club strives to maintain a comfortable and relaxing atmosphere for our guests, while still maintaining the desired character and demeanor of the Club. Proper attire is respectfully required for all Members and Guests.

### Adult Men's Dress Code

Gentlemen's shirts must have sleeves and either a collar or an appropriate mock turtleneck with a collar minimum of 1-1/4 inches. Sports jerseys and t-shirts for adults are not considered appropriate. Neatly tailored dress jeans, designer denim, Bermuda-style or dress cargo shorts are appropriate attire. Casual "cargo" shorts and hats are not permitted in the Main Dining Room and Main Bar.

### Adult Women's Dress Code

Dresses, skirts, slacks, neatly tailored dress jeans and designer denim are appropriate attire. Clothing appropriate for golf and tennis may also be worn.

### Additional Clubhouse Considerations

For the respect of your fellow members, we ask the membership not to use cell phones in any public dining area, to include, but not be limited to the main dining room, mixed grille, patio, etc.

Bathing suits, jogging suits, tank tops and cutoffs, should not be worn inside the clubhouse at anytime. Adults should also refrain from wearing casual "cargo" shorts, casual "cargo" pants, sports jerseys and t-shirts within the club house.

## Golf Dress Code

### Attire and Equipment

Members of Jefferson Country Club are expected to maintain the traditional image of the club by observing the Jefferson Country Club dress code while on the course or driving range. Gentlemen's shirts must have a collar and sleeves and be tucked in at all times. Mock turtleneck shirt collars must be a minimum of 1-1/4 inches. Shorts must be mid-length. Women may wear dresses, skirts, mid-length shorts, slacks and a proper golf shirt, with or without a collar. Hats must be worn properly. All players must have their own golf bags and clubs. Golf shoes with metal spikes are prohibited.

The following is not acceptable golf attire: bathing suits, jogging suits or shorts, coaching shorts, casual "cargo" shorts or pants, tennis dresses, tank tops or cutoffs. In addition, jeans or denim of any kind may not be worn at any time on the golf course or driving range. Shoes must be worn at all times. Junior golfers are expected to follow the standard dress code of all members. This dress code is mandatory for all players and their guests. Improperly dressed players will be asked to change before playing. If you are in doubt concerning your attire for the course, please call a member of Jefferson Country Club management before your tee time.
